

# Setting Up Macintosh OS X Dial-up

## Getting Started

### Introduction

This guide helps you to setup a Matisp.net dial-up account on a computer running Macintosh OS X.

## Getting Started

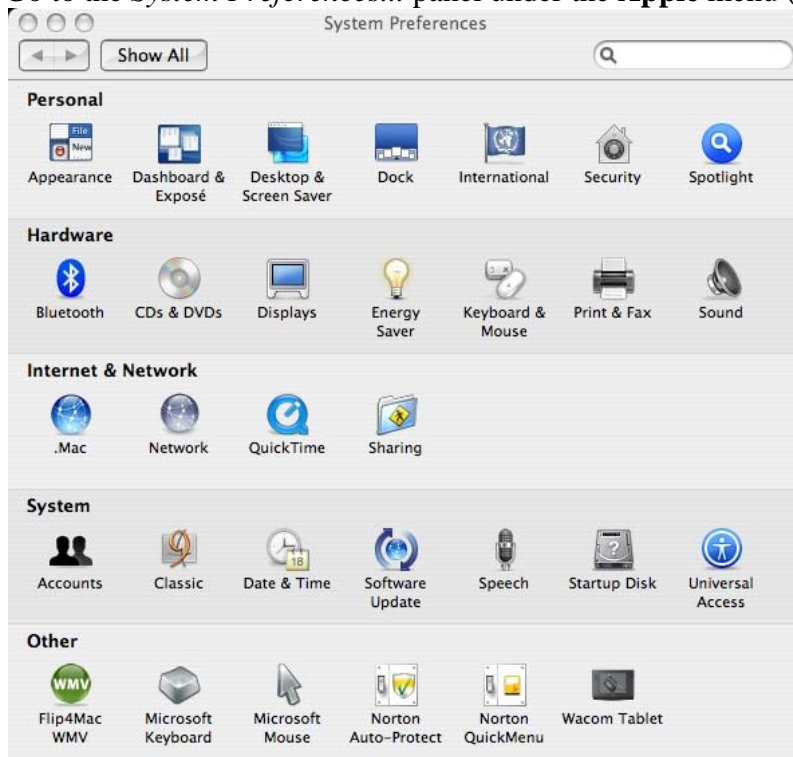


Figure 1: System Preferences panel

1. Go to the *System Preferences...* panel under the **Apple** menu (Figure 1). Click on the **Network** icon.

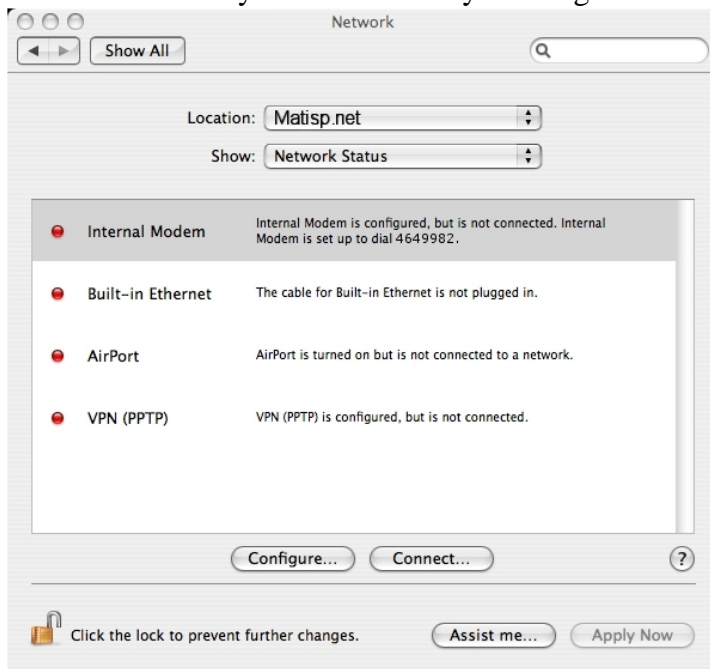
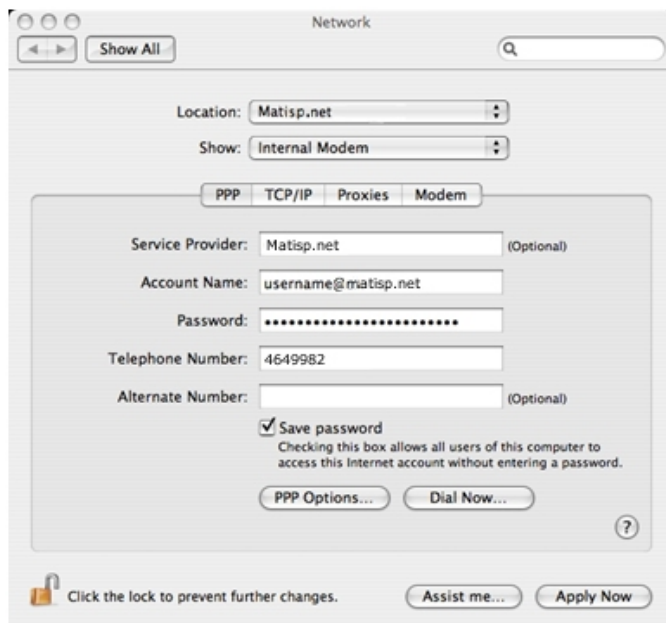


Figure 2: Network panel with Matsip.net location

2. In the *Network* panel select "New Location" in the **Location** menu and add MATISP.NET (Figure 2). Select the modem you wish to use by clicking on it and push the "Configure..." button.

3. Click on the "PPP" tab and enter:
  - o "Matsip.net" as your service provider
  - o In the "User name" field enter your MATISP.NET username followed by the domain "@matsip.net" (*username@matsip.net*). If your username is "johnpublic" then you would put "johnpublic@matsip.net" in the "User name" field.
  - o Enter your password in the "Password" field



- o "4649982" as the telephone number
4. Press "Apply Now" when finished.

# Connecting to the Internet

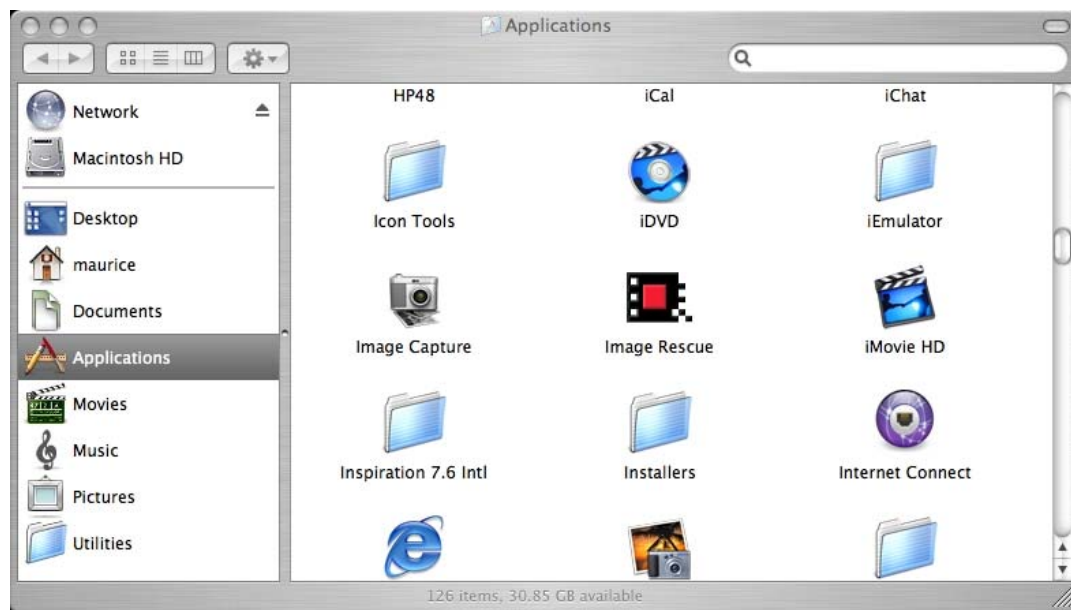


Figure 5: Applications Folder

1. Double click on "Internet Connect" (Figure 4) in your **Applications folder** (Figure 5)



Figure 4: Internet Connect Icon
